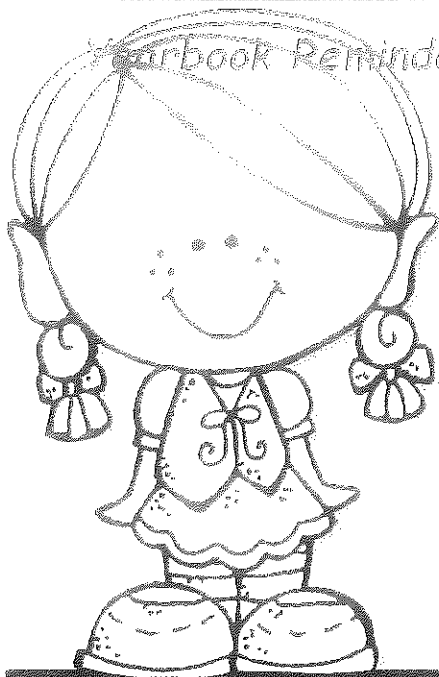


Yearbook Reminder: Last day for non-online orders March 2nd.

Chronic absence — missing 10 percent or more of school days due to absence for any reason—excused, unexcused absences and suspensions, can translate to academic risk.

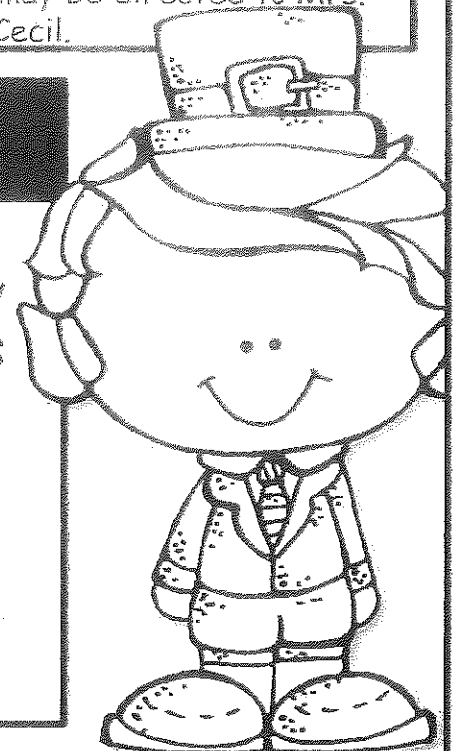
Please be mindful of the days your student is missing school.

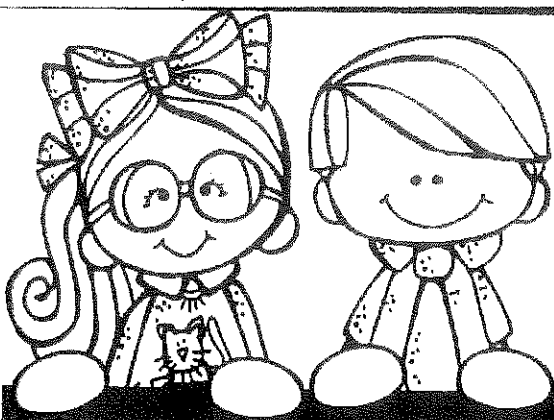
